This information helps us to understand your use of the website and its products. | Membership & Cart | pmpo_session / pmpo_visit | Tracks a user's session and membership status, ensuring restricted content is correctly served. | Essential (No Consent) |
| Membership & Cart | woocommerce_cart_hash | Helps WooCommerce identify when the contents of your shopping cart change. | Essential (No Consent) |
| Membership & Cart | woocommerce_items_in_cart | Stores basic data about the quantity of items currently in the cart. | Essential (No Consent) |
| Membership & Cart | wp_woocommerce_session_{hash} | Contains a unique code for each customer to link them to their cart data in the database. Expires after 2 days. | Essential (No Consent) |
| Consent Management | cmplz_consentstatus | Records and remembers your specific consent choices (Accepted/Denied) for future visits. | Essential (No Consent) |
| Analytics | (No Cookies Set) | We use Burst Statistics in "cookieless mode." This service counts visitors and page views without setting any tracking cookies on your device, ensuring maximum privacy. | Essential (No Cookies Set) |
| Marketing (Forms) | sib_cuid (Brevo/Sendinblue) | Used by our email service provider to track interactions with embedded forms and segment mailing lists. (Only set if a form is present and loaded.) | Consent Required (Marketing) |
| Statistics (Anti-spam) | _GRECAPTCHA | Set by Google reCAPTCHA to detect bots and prevent spam on registration forms or other forms. It may track user behaviour (mouse movements, etc). | Consent Required (Statistics/Marketing) |

We use an analytical tool that is set to be cookie less ie no cookie is placed.

Third party access to the cookies

The cookies we use will only be accessed by us and those third parties named in the table above for the purposes referred to in this cookie policy. Those cookies will not be accessed by any other third party.
